PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This conference will bring attendees up to date on substantial scientific advances and clinical interventions in the field of Addiction Medicine. Dr. Michael Miller will give an overview of the field. Subsequent speakers will target current and specific neurological, behavioral and therapeutic concepts and practices. This year, 3 Addiction Medicine Fellows from the John A. Burns School of Medicine, University of Hawai'i will present concise reviews of key medical and behavioral issues in the treatment of addicted persons.

Practical clinical interventions for addictive diseases have not been broadly integrated within the population of care providers with the greatest exposure to persons at risk. This is manifest by the huge demand for services that cannot be met by Addiction Medicine specialists alone. This conference is designed to give information and skills to physicians and other professionals who encounter these patients most frequently, and thus have the best opportunity to intervene, treat or refer.

CONTINUING MEDICAL EDUCATION

This activity has been planned and implemented in accordance with the Essential Areas and Policies of the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) through the joint sponsorship of the Hawaii Consortium for Continuing Medical Education (HCCME) and the Hawaii Society of Addiction Medicine. 3. Participants will be familiar with special issues in relation to the care of addicted persons, including medical co-morbidities, and considerations in the treatment of women and of adolescents.
